

Northwoods Bowmen's Board Meeting Minutes 7 July 2014

Approval of Minutes: Bob read the meeting minutes from June. No additions or corrections noted. Motion to approve the minutes made by Ruth. Seconded by Joe. Approved by voice vote.

Membership: provided by Greg: 2014 memberships currently reflect 19 adults, 9 seniors, 51 families (153 individuals), and 7 junior/student for a total of 188 individuals.

Treasury: provided by Ruth: Current balances reflect Checking - \$3,464.03 Money Market - \$10,684.43 and Savings - \$187.50 for a total of \$14,335.96. Ruth distributed a statement of accounts through June 2014 with comparisons to last year.

Range: provided by Todd: Target cardboards have been glued. More need to be constructed and, once complete, a work party called for target gluing.

Awards: provided by Brian: He has fallen behind on updating the dry erase board at the barn. There was discussion if it was needed as scores are posted at the web site. It was decided that the dry erase board should be populated coincident with the web site. Bryan will work to update.

Web & Publicity: provided by Jason: The web site is running well and gets 50-60 "hits" on a bad day and 90-100 "hits" on a good day. Keith mentioned that he's received numerous inquiries about the club generated from the web site. Training and scheduling appear to be working well and the email notifications to instructors is functioning as designed. JOAD: no report – Doug not present.

Old Business:

- Range sponsored shirts – A new digital yellow logo has been created. It was passed around the table and met with the approval of all board members. We need to move forward with creation of merchandise (shirts, hats, etc.) that can be available for sale. (See new business)
- Permanently mounted fans for the club – will need new electrical panel installed
- Proposed once per month certified trainers meeting. - Joe, Jason, Doug, Todd
- Arrows to be ordered for JOAD and ITA use only.

New Business:

- Bryan wanted to clarify scoring and awards as it relates to the league shoots. If you start the league shooting one style (bowhunter) and switch mid-league to another style (recurve), you will not be eligible for awards unless one shooting style was used for half + 1 of that league. In a 10 week league you would need to shoot one style at 6 of the league competitions. In an 8 week league you would need to shoot one style at 5 of the league competitions. If you don't meet this requirement the club will track your scores but remove them in the final calculations. You must be a club member to receive club awards. Drop in's will be tracked but not included in the final calculations. Next league will be 3D, followed by Zombie, then followed by Vegas.
